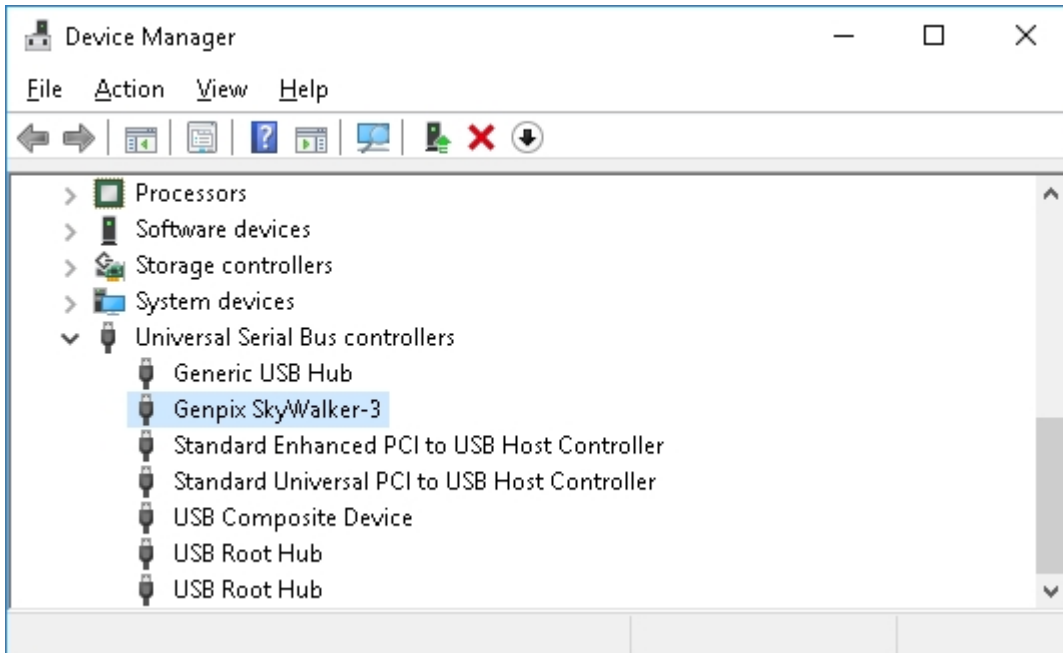


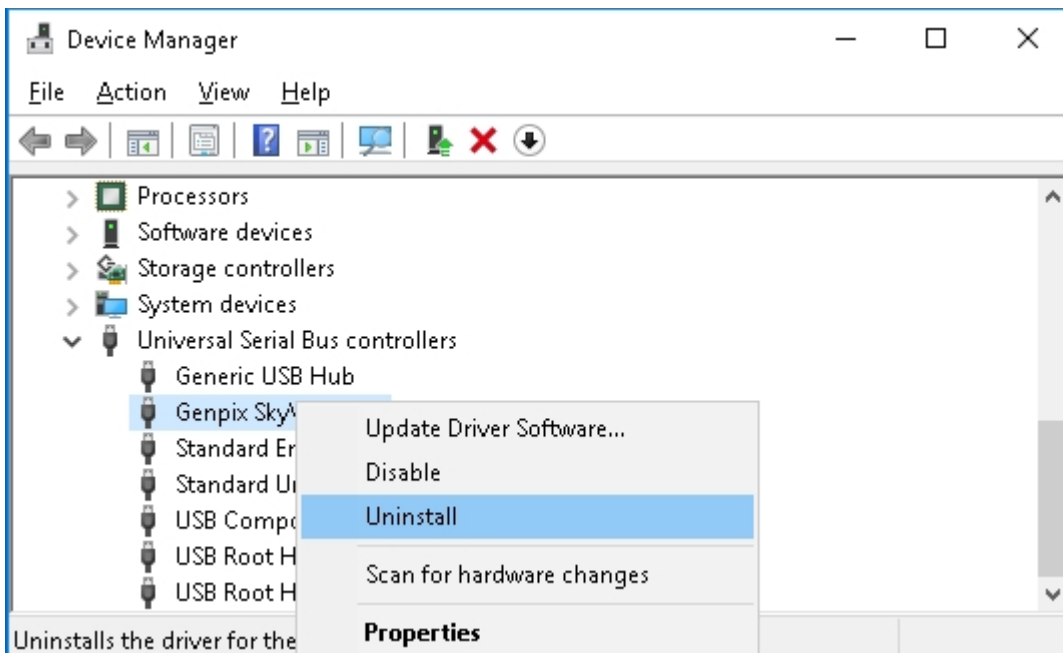
# Windows 10 / Windows Server 2016 installation

1. Install your hardware (SkyWalker-3 in this example) when you PC is switched Off.
2. Boot Windows 10, open **Device Manager**.
3. If this is a new installation continue with step 7.

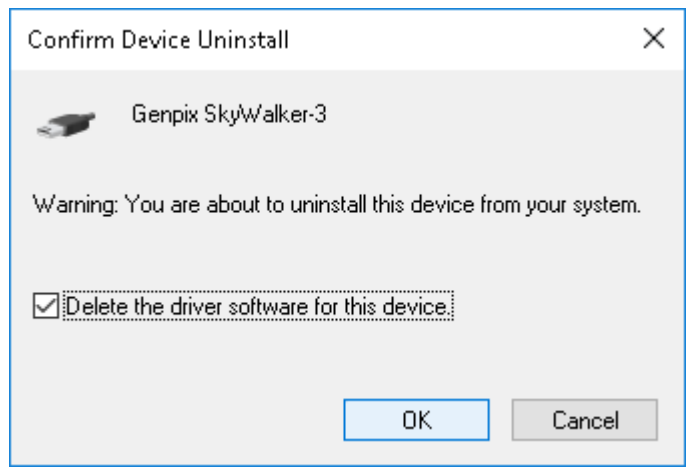
Otherwise, if you are upgrading from previous version of the driver, expand USB controllers section:



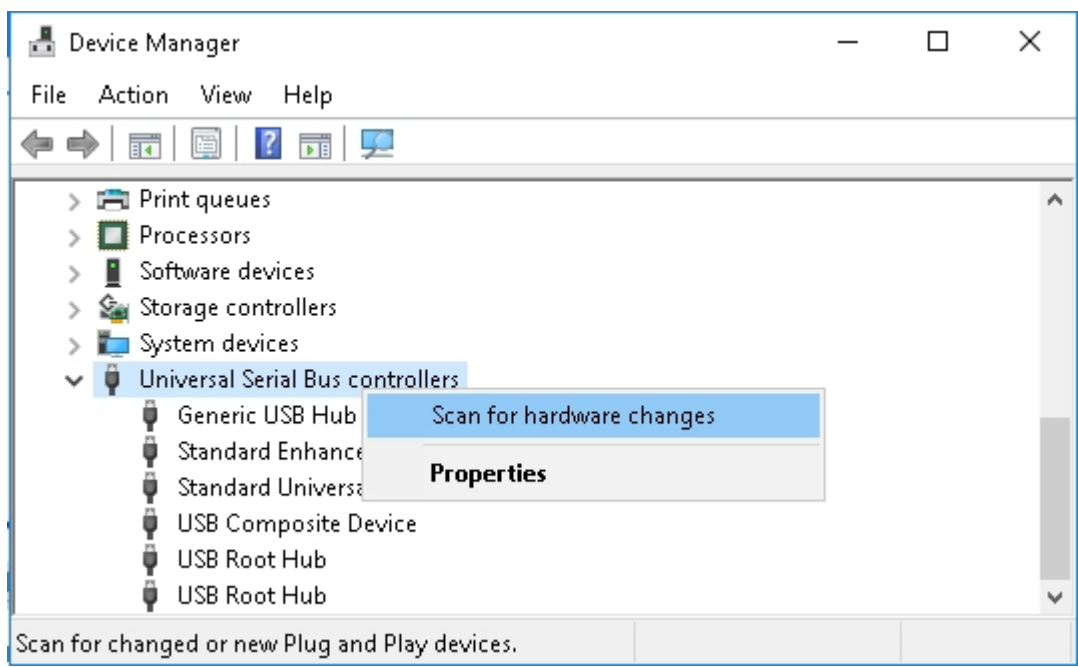
4. Select Genpixmap device which you have in this section, right-click on it and choose **Uninstall**.



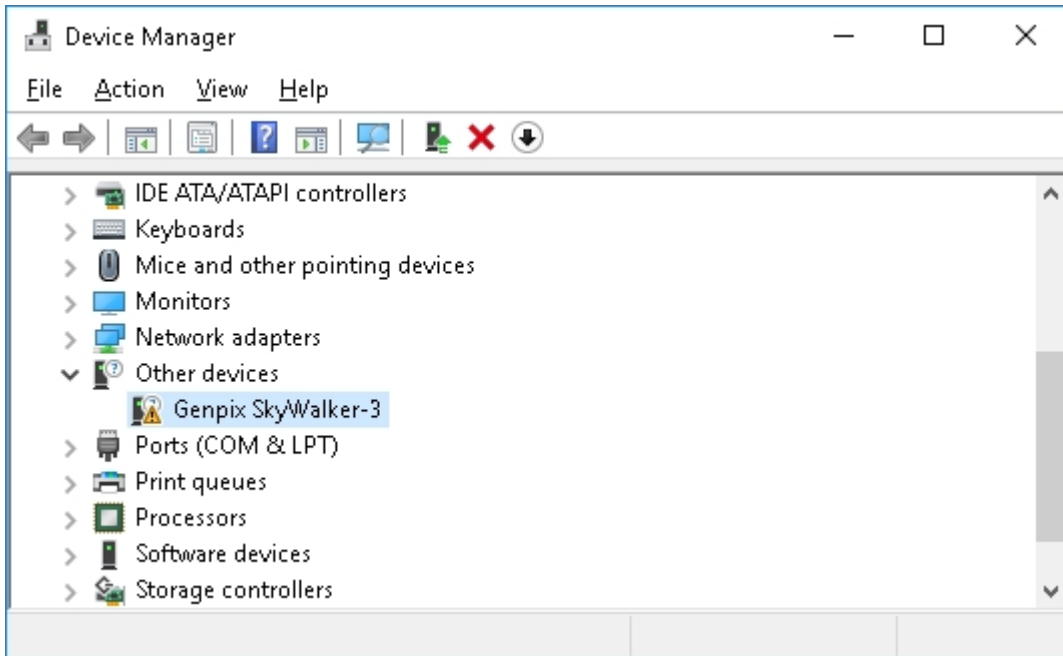
5. Make sure “**Delete the driver software for this device**” option is selected. Click **OK** button.



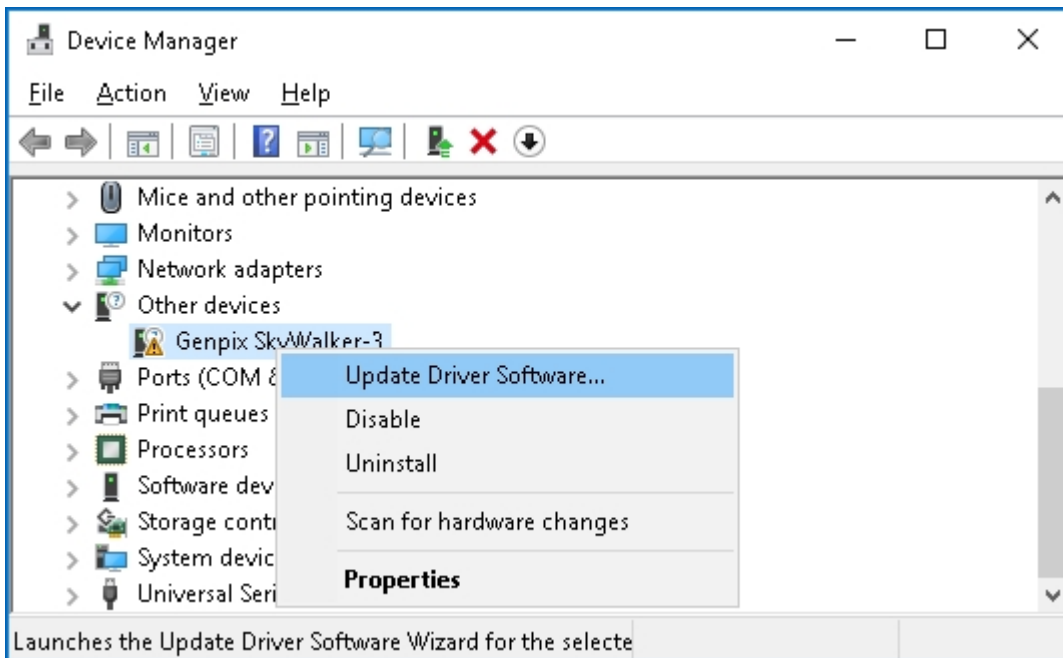
6. Right-click on any of the USB devices in the list and select “**Scan for hardware changes**”.



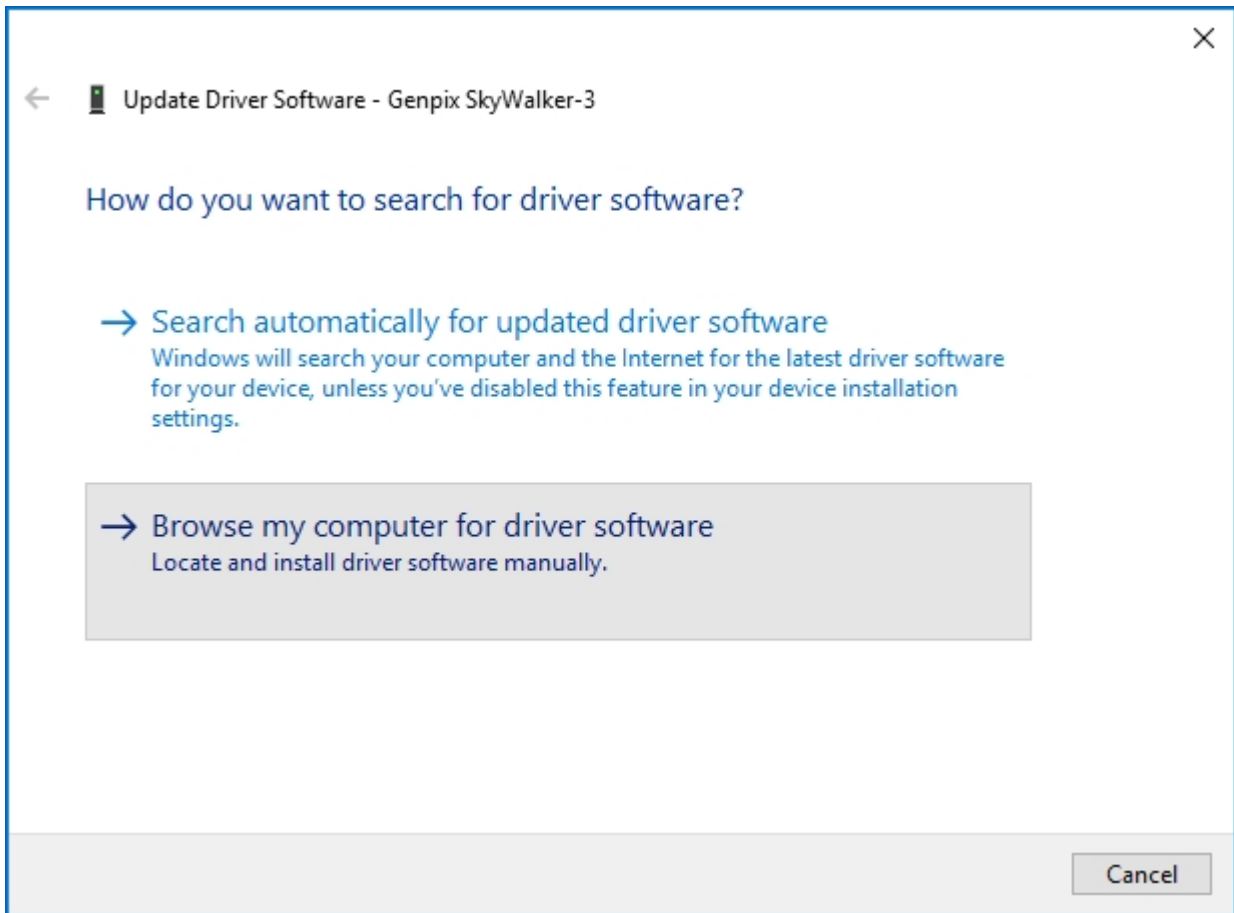
7. Windows will prompt that a new device is found, and it will place new Genpox device into the Other devices section. Since there is no driver installed yet, Genpox device will have yellow exclamation mark:



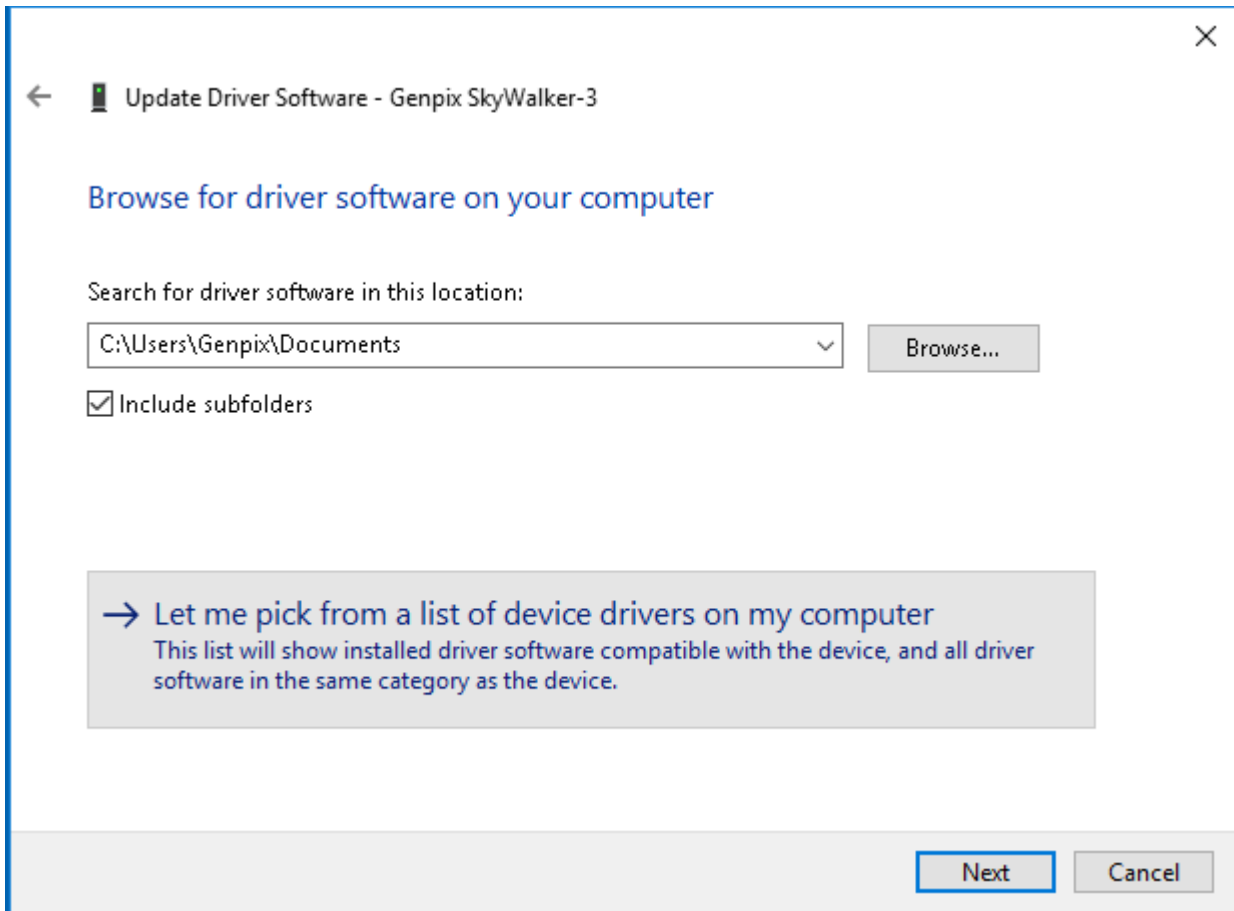
8. Right-click on Genpox device, and select **Update Driver Software** option:



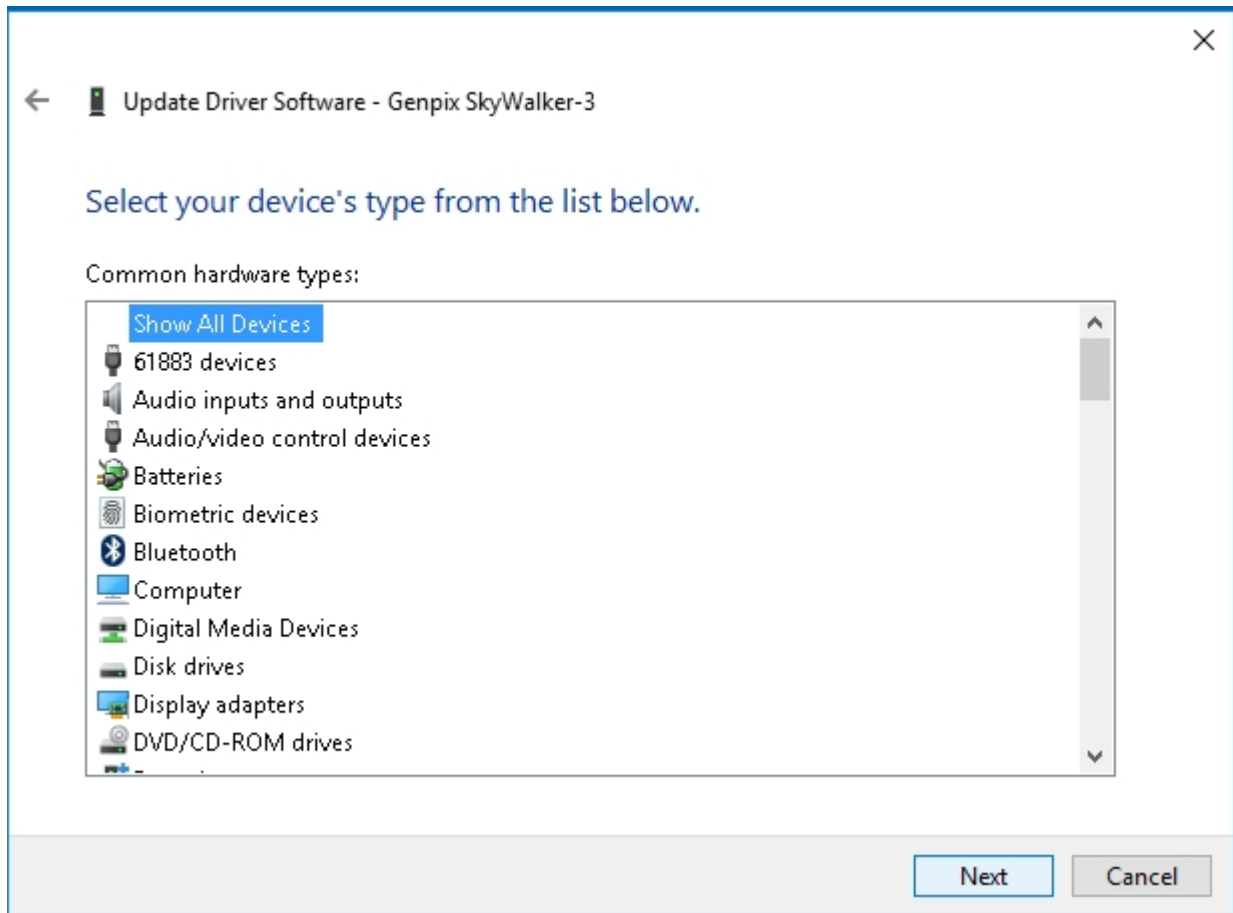
9. In the pop-up window, do not allow windows to search automatically for the drive. Instead, select **Browse my computer for driver software** option:



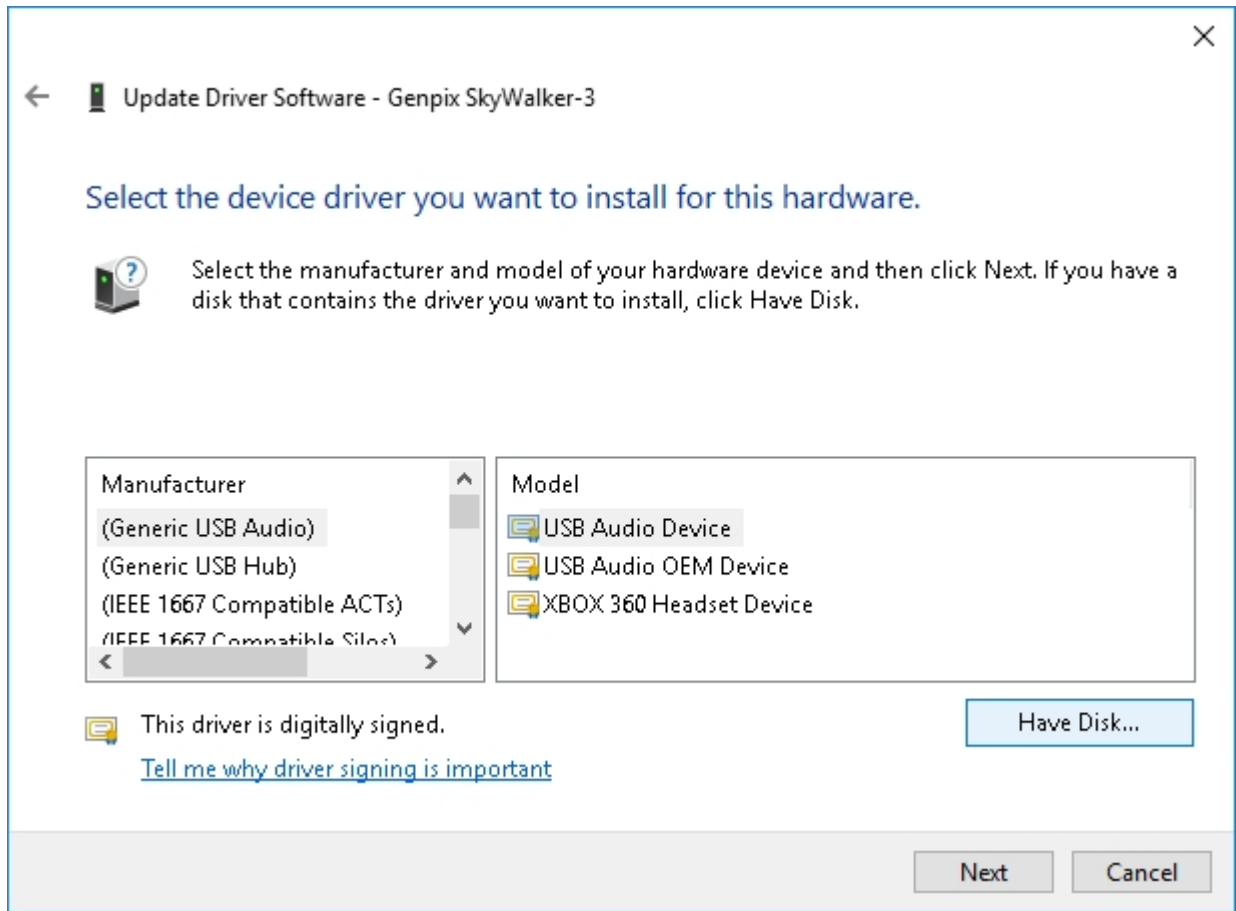
10. In the next windows, select **Let me pick from a list of device drivers on my computer** option:



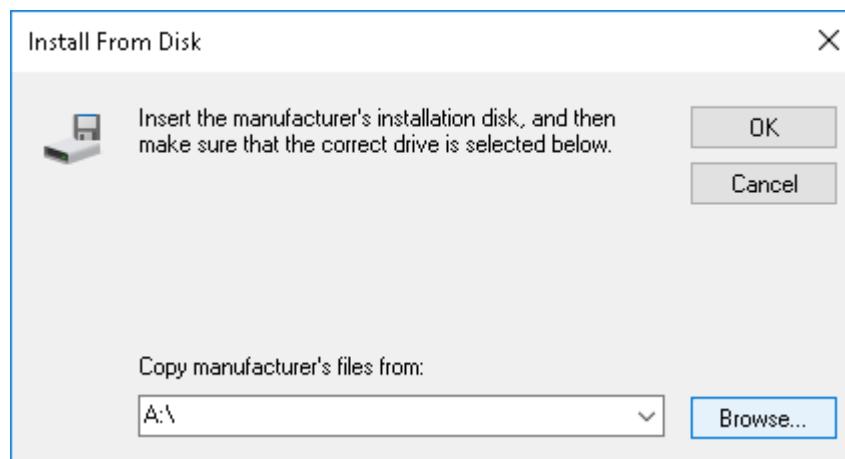
11. Click **Next** button in the next window:



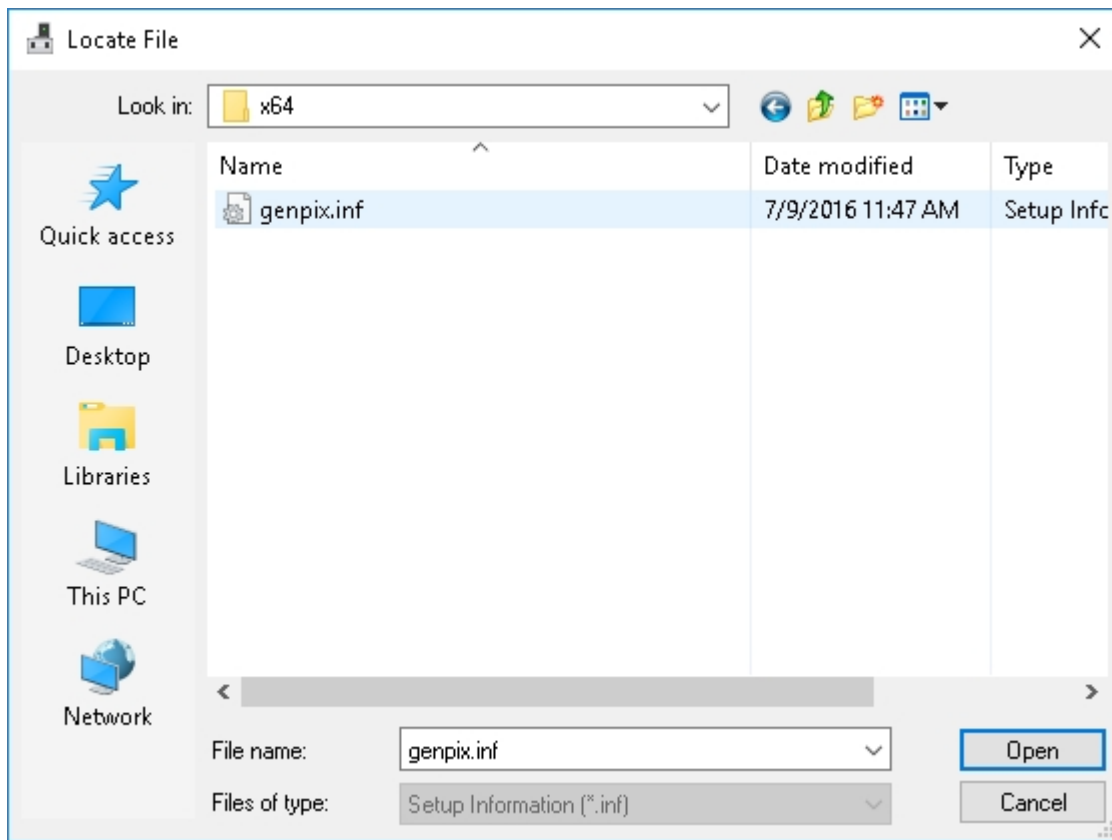
12. Click **Have Disk...** button in the next window:



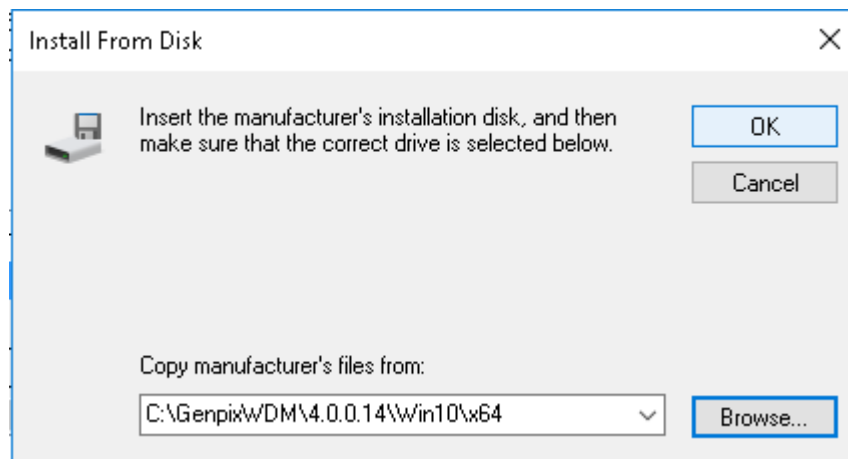
13. Click on the **Browse...** button in the next pop-up window:



14. Browse to the folder where a new Genpix Driver is located (select the folder with a proper Windows version: if you use Windows 10 64-bit version, go to Win10\x64\ folder). Select **genpix.inf** file and click **Open** button:

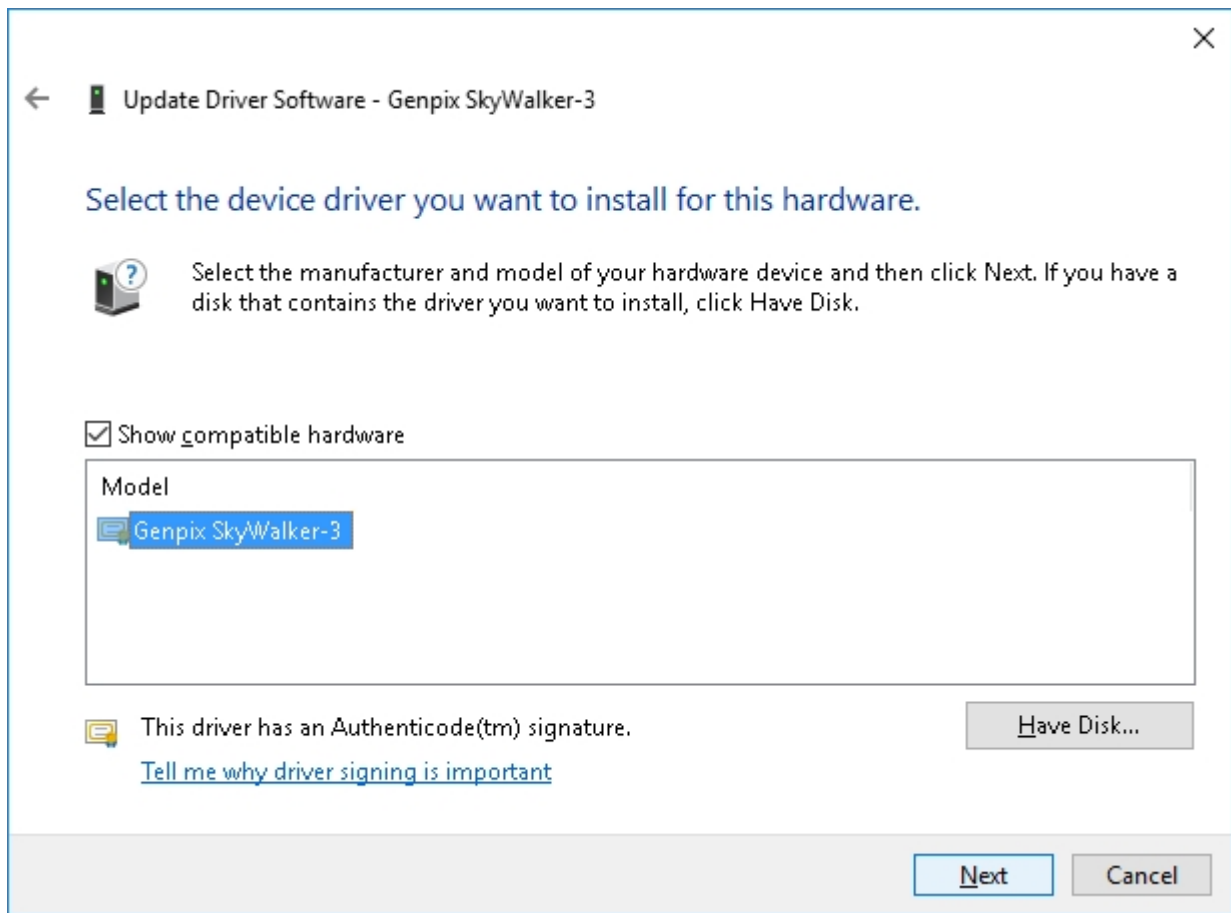


15. Click OK button in the next window:

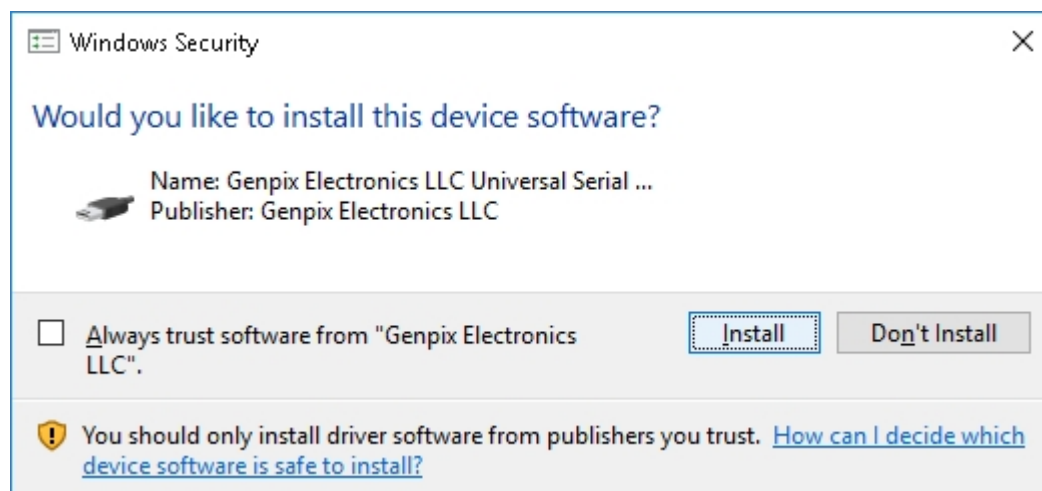




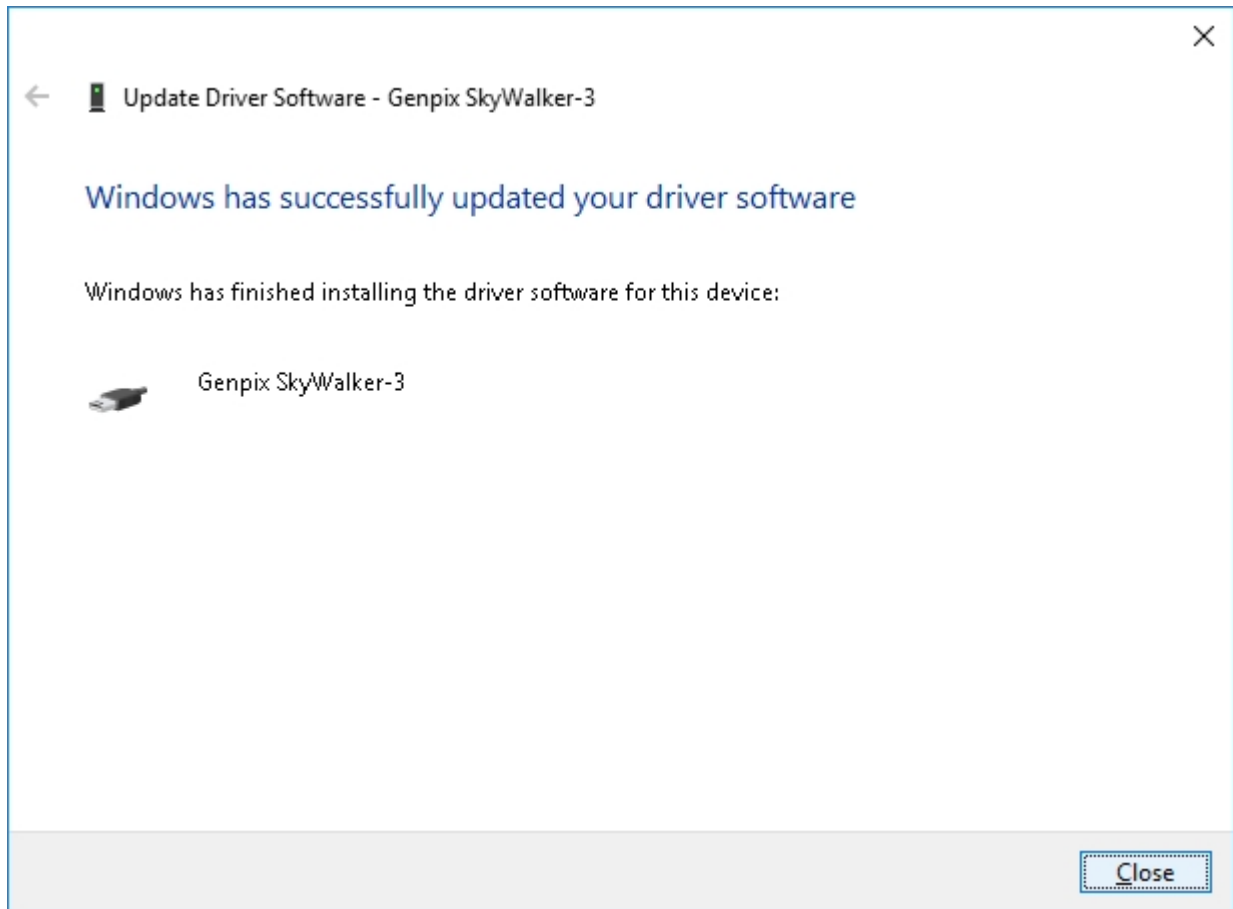
16. Select a proper device from the list of detected devices (**Genpix SkyWalker-3** in this case), and click the **Next** button:



17. Confirm that Windows properly recognized the digital signature of the driver, and click Install button:



18. Wait until windows successfully installs the driver. Then click **Close** button:



19. You should see a new Genpox device in the USB controller section (and no exclamation mark anymore):
